RE: EDEXIS Transition to EAMS

Dear EDEX User:

On Monday August 25, 2008 the California Division of Workers' Compensation (DWC) will implement its new Electronic Adjudication Management System (EAMS) at workers' compensation appeals board offices statewide. In preparation for this "go-live" date the DWC has set a lien filing cut-off date two weeks prior on August 8. **This cut-off date is mandatory for all lien filers.**

On Monday August 11 the DWC will begin limited conversion to the new EAMS data system. Through Friday August 8 the DWC will continue to accept electronically-filed EDEX liens and manually-filed paper liens. After August 8 no further electronic lien filing will be permitted and the DWC is encouraging the use of the new EAMS optical character recognition (OCR) documentation for all manual filing. The OCR documentation will be mandatory as of October 15. This OCR format is still under development by the DWC and is not yet publicly available. Once the new forms are finalized they will be accessible in your EDEXIS account.

Due to the rapidly approaching lien cut-off date we **strongly encourage** you to file all of your outstanding liens electronically before August 8. Many of our EDEX customers are already in the process of uploading large batches of liens to guarantee they are all entered into the DWC data system prior to August 8. If you have a large batch to upload please contact our office to discuss our 50% batch upload discount and our data management assistance.

EDEX Information Systems has also been working closely with the DWC to design and implement many changes to the EDEX system to make it fully integrate with EAMS. Several new services will soon be available in your account, including an electronic document mailing and storage service to remotely print and deliver high-quality OCR-formatted documents to WCAB offices. This new service will provide guaranteed delivery of your liens, Declarations of Readiness forms, Applications for Adjudication and other forms and supporting documents.
